

## Discussion Questions:

1. What are some ways that a Life Group can fulfill the Great Commandment of Matthew 22:39 with each other this Spring?
  - a. What are the things that will typically get in your way in pursuit of fulfilling the Great Commandment?
  - b. If we are not fulfilling the Great Commandment well, what is probably missing according to Matthew 22:37?
  - c. How connected are these two elements of the Great Commandment?
  - d. Can you have one element without the other?
  - e. If you are doing one element of the Great Commandment, will it lead you into automatically doing the other element of it?
2. Why do you think that Christians in America especially the Bible Belt are increasingly connect their spirituality more to the preaching ministry of their pastor than to a group of people in church?
3. Consider Matthew 28:18-20. What parts of this Gospel Commission is a church like CBC stronger and weaker in fulfilling?
  - a. How can a Life Group bring strength to the ways CBC is weak at fulfilling the Gospel Commission?
  - b. Why do you think that people get more excited about the “teaching them” element of the Gospel Commission than the “go” element?
  - c. What does it look like for a person, church, and Life Group to fulfill the Gospel Commission?
4. Consider Acts 1:8. Why are we more passionate about getting to Gospel to “the end of the earth” more than our own “Jerusalem”?
5. What are some outreach projects that your Life Group could partner together in this Spring?
